### Reading Comprehension Subtest

82.99 or below - ENG\* 073 - Academic Reading

### Sentence Skills Subtest

87.99 or below - ENG\* 043 - Writing: Paragraph to Essay

88 and higher **AND** Reading Comprehension is higher than 83

ENG\* 101 - English Composition

### Alternate Method for Placement: SAT Scores

- Critical Reading of score 450 or higher **or** Writing score of 450 or higher is placement in ENG\* 101

### Alternate Method for Placement: ACT Scores

- ACT English portion with score of 21 or higher is placement in ENG\* 101
- ACT English and Reading portions score of 47 or higher is placement in ENG\* 101

33.99 or below - MAT\* 075 - Prealgebra - Number Sense, Geometry

### Elementary Algebra Subtest

34 – 64.99 - MAT\* 095 - Elementary Algebra Foundations

### Elementary Algebra Subtest

65 and higher - MAT\* 123 - Elementary Statistics  
- MAT\* 137 - Intermediate Algebra

### College Level Math Subtest

60.99 or below - MAT\* 123 - Elementary Statistics  
- MAT\* 137 - Intermediate Algebra

### College Level Math Subtest

61 – 99.99 - MAT\* 146 - Math for Liberal Arts  
- MAT\* 167 - Principles of Statistics  
- MAT\* 186 - Precalculus

### College Level Math Subtest

100 and higher - MAT\* 254 - Calculus I

### Alternate Method for Placement: SAT Scores

- Math score of 400 to 499 is placement in MAT\* 095: Elementary Algebra Foundations
- Math score of 500 to 549 is placement in MAT\* 137: Intermediate Algebra or MAT\* 123: Elementary Statistics
- Math score of 550 or 599 is placement in MAT\* 146: Math for Liberal Arts, MAT\* 167: Principles of Statistics, or MAT\* 186: Precalculus
- Math score of 600 or higher – see Math Coordinator for placement options

### Alternate Method for Placement: ACT Scores

- ACT Math score of 18 to 21 is placement in MAT\* 137: Intermediate Algebra or MAT\* 123: Elementary Statistics
- ACT Math score of 22 to 23 is placement in MAT\* 146: Math for Liberal Arts, MAT\* 167: Principles of Statistics, or MAT\* 186: Precalculus
- ACT Math score of 24 to 36 – see Math Coordinator for placement options

### AP Exams

Advanced Placement (AP) exam scores of 3, 4, or 5 are accepted for credit for the specific academic discipline in which the test was taken. (Students must provide ACC with the official AP transcript for each exam completed)
